Use of papers

- Papers may be used by teachers who purchased it as examination on the date as decided, or (at your own risk) at a later date.
- Teachers may adapt and use the papers as revision exercises or tests/tasks at a later stage.
- Non-commercial use. The papers may not be sold and Study Opportunities owns the copyright to the paper, altered/edited or in the original.

Distribution of papers

- The question papers and memorandums will be loaded on the website (www.studyopportunities.co.za). CAT papers and memorandums will also be available on Pam's blog (studyopp.blogspot.com).
- You will need to download these papers and memorandums yourself; they will not be sent to individual e-mail addresses.
- *Passwords for the papers* will be made available by SMS at least 3 days prior to the date of the exam.
- The passwords for the *memorandums* will be made available on the day of the exams.

Preparing for a practical examination

We suggest that you do the following checks once you have received the passwords to extract the files:

- You may adapt and customise the paper if you wish to, by adding your own school name / logo at the top.
- You may want to quickly scan the paper and make any minor adjustments you deem fit. We would suggest that you keep these changes to a minimum as it might affect the balance of the paper in terms of the weightings with respect to the degrees of difficulty.
- If there are English and Afrikaans versions of the DATA files, we suggest you provide just the one version to avoid confusion for your learners.
- Check that you have all the main data files.
- Check that the main data files open on your school's computers.
