

Study Opportunities' Grade 10 & 11 Exams for November 2020

Study Opportunities is currently looking at changes being made to the Grade 10 & 11 exams for November 2020, in the light of the '2020 Revised Curriculum and Assessment Plans' of DBE.

Examination dates:

We are aware of the holiday 23-30 Oct 2020. However, there might be private schools who will be writing exams during that time. So we are NOT going to change our dates – and as always, you may write the exams LATER. **But we again ask that teachers take back all the question papers directly after the examination, and keep them securely locked away.**

Content:

Several topics have been moved by DBE to 2021, but there are schools that have completed these topics and want to examine them. We will be setting Theory and Practical papers for Grades 10 and 11 that cover ALL the work (except PowerPoint for Grade 10).

Marks and times:

It appears that the type of papers (time, marks and content) that schools will write will differ. Some schools might write one written paper per grade, and others might have a Theory as well as a Practical examination.

Study Opportunities will have ONE Theory paper and ONE Practical paper for each grade. The Time and Marks will be as follows:
